Swine Flu

Anyone suffering from swine flu symptoms should not mix with others and should stay at home until recovered. Arriving and departing

We ask that all parents park a distance from school and then walk. There is plenty of parking available in higher Warberry Road and in the roads surrounding the school. Please do not arrive earlier than 8.40am in the morning unless attending Breakfast Club. The school day ends at 3.15pm. Please collect promptly. Pupils who are not collected on time will go to After School Club and parents will be billed. There is a voluntary one-way system operating in Cedars Road at the beginning and end of the school day. Please only drive down Cedars Road at these times. Thank you.

Please say goodbye to your children as they walk towards the KS1 playground. We do not allow parents into the school building with children in the morning. Only Reception parents come into the classrooms while their children are settling in.

Please come to the 'Meet the Teacher' sessions organised at the beginning of this term. If you would like to see a member of staff please come to the main office and the staff there will arrange an appointment for you.

Improvements to the Building

When you come into school you will see many improvements including; new ceilings and lights, new carpeting and non slip flooring, double doors onto the KS1 playground, new taps and liquid soap dispensers at all sinks.

Naming clothing and Lost Property

We are unable to cope with the vast amount of lost property items which accumulate in school. Year 6 pupils are very good at delivering any named items back to children in the school. PLEASE put your child's name in all school clothing including PE clothes and coats. School staff will write (with a laundry marker) a child's name on the wash/name label in coats and cardigans and jumpers if this has not been done because these are the items most frequently misplaced. Water bottles also need to be named please.
